



WEST HAWAII ASSOCIATION OF REALTORS ANNUAL AWARDS

Award Committee (Chaired by Secretary and comprised of AE and all immediate past year's winners) communicates the Nomination Criteria and Application to general membership via broadcast.

- 1) *Members nominate themselves or others, being sure to submit how nominee meets the criteria for the category being nominated.*
- 2) *Nominations are received by AE who then removes names to allow blind consideration by committee members, who then select winners based on criteria only.*
- 3) *Staff conducts verification of primary membership in good standing, no COE/DCCA violations last five years, etc.*
- 4) *Please note: there will be no member-wide voting for awards. Participation of the membership in the Awards process will be done by way of the Nominations themselves. Therefore, if you believe someone should be considered to win an Award (yourself or someone else) please do nominate them and tell us why!*
- 5) *Awards will be announced at incoming President's Annual Banquet/Awards Ceremony held on December 5, 2018.*

ALL AWARDS REQUIRE PRIMARY MEMBERSHIP IN WHAR TO BE ELIGIBLE. ALL PAST YEAR WINNERS WILL SERVE ON AWARDS COMMITTEE FOLLOWING YEAR. NO MEMBER WILL BE ELIGIBLE TO WIN THE SAME AWARD TWO YEARS IN A ROW.

AFFILIATE OF THE YEAR

1. Be a dues paying affiliate member for all of 2018.
2. Award is based on service and accomplishments at the local board
3. Any member may nominate an affiliate.
4. Applicant must have demonstrated ethical conduct.
5. Level of participation in the Board events, committees, etc. will be considered.

ROOKIE OF THE YEAR

1. Have an active Salesperson's license and must have no prior licensed sales experience in the real estate industry.
2. Applicants for Rookie of the Year must apply within the first 24 months of original licensing activation.
3. Award is based on accomplishments for any twelve (12) consecutive months during the agent's first 18 months after licensing.
4. Any broker may submit an application of any of their finest agents.
5. Applicant must have demonstrated ethical conduct. Someone having been found in violation of ethical conduct will not be considered for the award.
6. A person can only win Rookie of the Year one time.
7. Level of participation in the Board events, committees, etc. will be considered

REALTOR® (SALES) OF THE YEAR

1. Applicant must have an active salesperson or broker license for the entire year of 2018.
2. Applicant must have been in the real estate profession for at least one year.
3. Past award recipients may NOT apply again in the same category.
4. Level of participation in the Board events, committees, etc. will be considered.

COMMITMENT TO PERSONAL AND ASSOCIATE EDUCATION:

- a. Current professional designations
- b. Seminars, professional or ongoing education courses taken within the last twelve months.
- c. Examples of support given to all REALTORS®, whether inside or outside the nominee's firm, to include training, mentoring and education, whether voluntary or with compensation.

HALL OF FAME/LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT

Intended to recognize outstanding career sales performance, professionalism and participation resulting in successful and sustained promotion of their own business as well as the industry and the board. Must be a member in good standing for at least 10 years.
